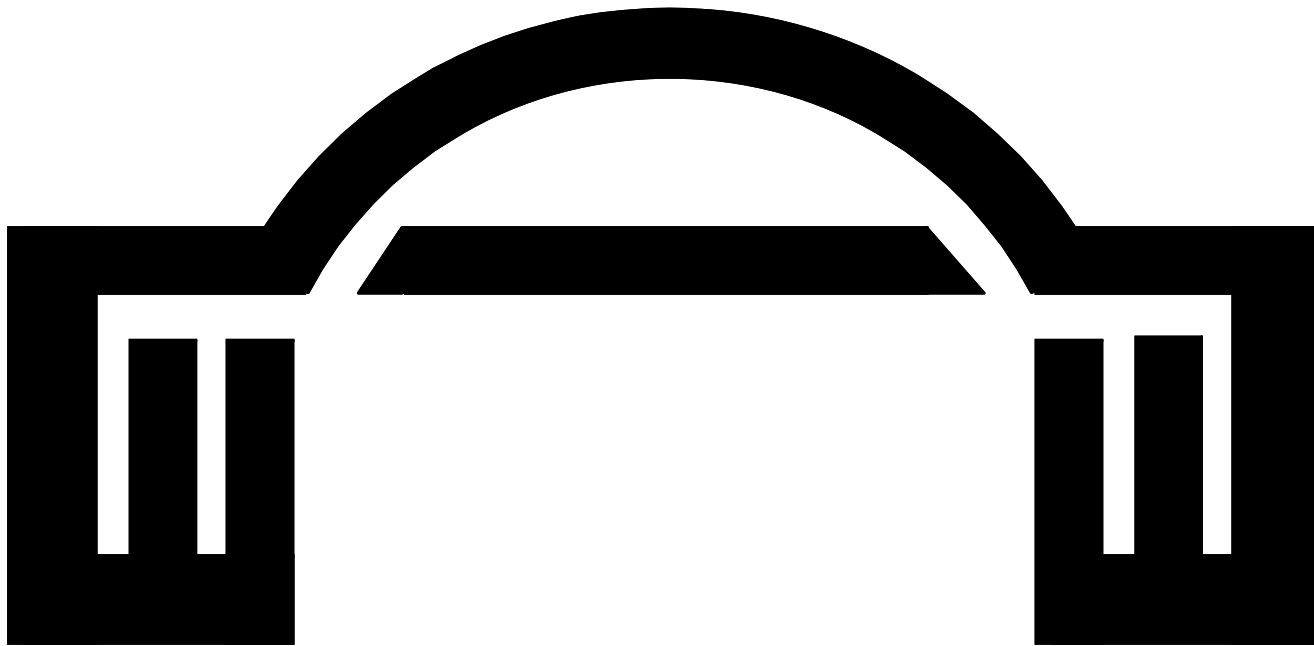

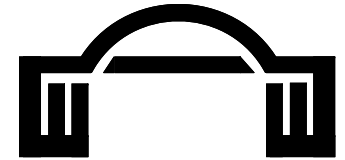

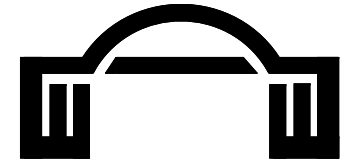

Methodology and Response Rates for the 2009 Legislative Effectiveness Survey



The N.C. Center for Public Policy Research conducted its legislative survey during November and December of 2009. At that time, all 50 state Senators, 119* Representatives, 471 registered lobbyists (including the lead state agency legislative liaisons), and 14 state capital news correspondents were asked to rate the effectiveness of each member of the North Carolina General Assembly on a scale of one to 10. Senators were asked to rank only other Senators, and Representatives rated only their fellow Representatives.

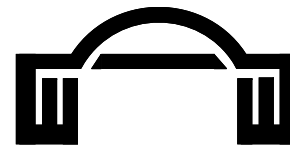
Seventy-one of the 119* House members (60%) responded to the Center's survey, as did 28 of the 50 Senators (56%), 156 of the 471 lobbyists and lead legislative liaisons based in North Carolina (33%), and 8 of 14 capital news correspondents (57%). The overall response rate was 40%.

The survey's purpose was to identify the most effective legislators in the General Assembly. The Center asked respondents to base their ratings on legislators' participation in committee work, their skill at guiding bills through committee and floor debate, their general knowledge and expertise in special fields, the respect they command from peers, his or her ethics, the enthusiasm with which they execute various legislative responsibilities, the political power they hold (by virtue of office, longevity, or personal skills), their ability to sway the opinions of fellow legislators, and their aptitude for the overall legislative process. Respondents were asked to use these criteria, as well as their own personal knowledge of the General Assembly and personal perceptions of those who serve there, in replying to the Center's questionnaire.

The following pages list the effectiveness rankings for the 2009 North Carolina Senate and House of Representatives and include rankings from previous legislative sessions where applicable.

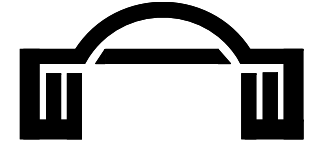

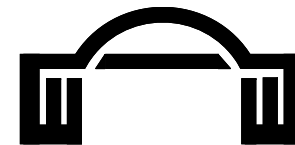

2009 N.C. House of Representatives Effectiveness Rankings, Alphabetical Order by Representative

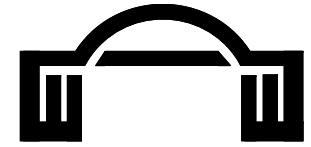

ATTENDANCE RULES FOR EACH CHAMBER

SENATE RULE 70. Absence without leave: No Senator or officer of the Senate shall depart the service of the Senate without leave or receive pay as a Senator or officer for the time absent without leave.

HOUSE RULE 54. Attendance of Members: No member or officer of the House shall be absent from the service of the House without leave, unless from sickness or disability.

TERMS USED IN ATTENDANCE TABLES

Party-County: This is the political party and the home county of the legislator. (“D” indicates Democrats, “R” indicates Republicans).

Legislative Days: This is the total number of days the legislative chamber met during 2009. The Senate met for 112 days, and the House met for 114 days between January 28, 2009 and August 11, 2009.

Days Fully Absent: This is the number of legislative days for which official records of the House and the Senate indicate that a member received an excused absence from the legislative session for the entire day.

Days Partially Absent: This is the number of legislative days that official records of the House and the Senate indicate that a member received an excused absence from the legislative session for a portion of the day.

Total Days with Absences: This is the number of days partially absent added to the number of days fully absent.

Legislative Days Present: This is the number of days that each legislator was present for the entire day. It is derived by subtracting the total number of days the legislator was recorded as being absent from the total number of legislative days.

Percent of Days Present: This is the percentage of total legislative days for which the legislator was present. It is obtained by dividing the number of days present by the total number of legislative days.

Attendance Rank: This is a ranking of legislators by the percentage of days present. A lower ranking indicates higher attendance while a higher ranking indicates lower attendance.

VOTING PARTICIPATION RULES FOR EACH CHAMBER

SENATE RULE 29. Duty to vote; excuses. – (a): Every Senator who is within the Senate Chamber when the question is stated by the Presiding Officer shall vote thereon unless that Senator is excused by the Senate.

HOUSE RULE 24. Roll Call Vote. – (b): Every member who is in the Hall of the House when the question is put shall vote upon a call of the ayes and noes, unless excused pursuant to Rule 24.1A. *[24.1A details excuses]*.

TERMS USED IN VOTING PARTICIPATION TABLES

Party-County: This is the political party and the home county of the legislator. (“D” indicates Democrats, “R” indicates Republicans).

Senate’s/House’s Total Votes: This is the total number of electronically recorded roll call votes for that chamber during the 2009 legislative session. The Senate recorded 1,211 roll call votes, and the House recorded 1,375 votes.

Absent or Excused from Voting: This is the total number of electronically recorded roll call votes for which the legislator was absent or excused from voting under the rules.

Maximum Votes Could Have Cast While Present: This is the number of votes a legislator could have cast once the number of absent or excused votes for each legislator is subtracted from the total votes taken that session.

Actual Votes Cast: This is the actual number of electronically recorded roll call votes cast by the legislator.

Percent of Voting Participation: This is the percentage of the maximum possible votes that the legislator actually voted. It is obtained by dividing the actual votes cast by the maximum votes the legislator could have cast while present.

Voting Participation Rank: This is a ranking of legislators by their percentage of voting participation. A lower ranking indicates a higher voting percentage while a higher ranking indicates a lower voting percentage.

Paired Voting Rule: The state Senate has a rule (Rule 27) that allows a member who has an excused absence to record a vote on a specific measure by having a Senator who is present and plans to vote the opposite way on the measure announce the pairing.

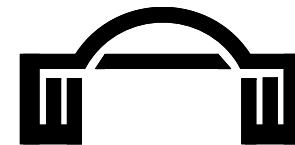

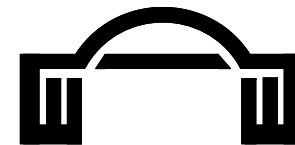

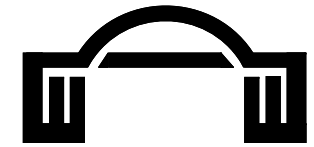
