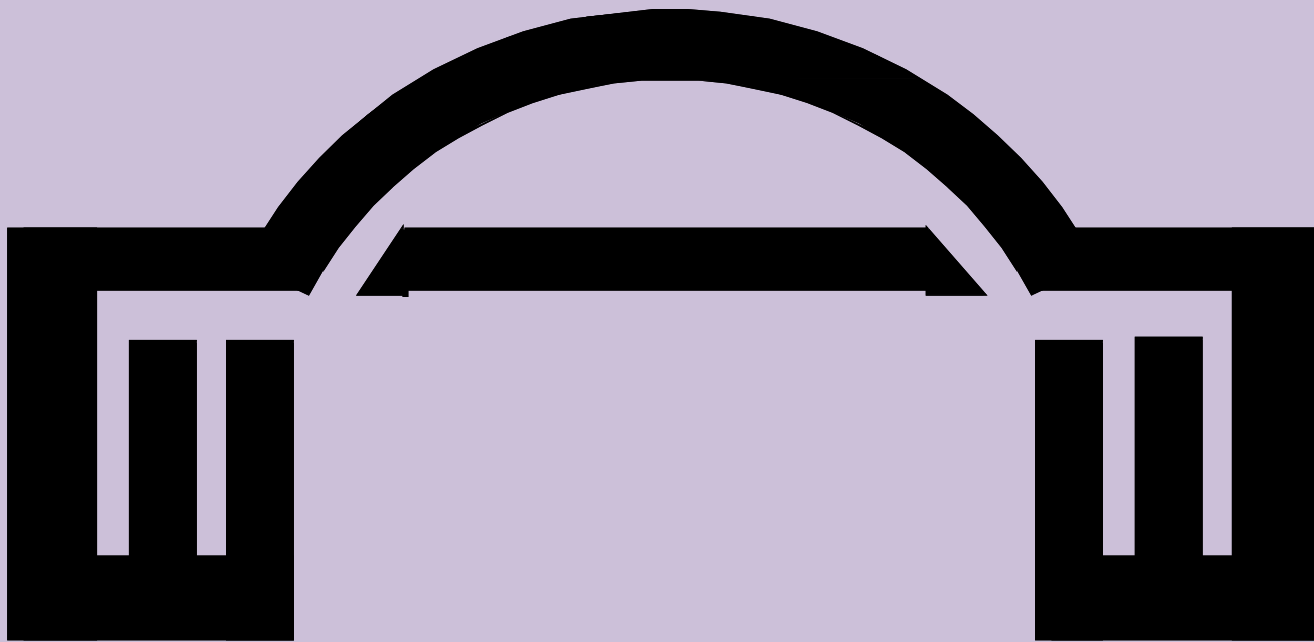

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Methodology and Response Rates for the 2013 Legislative Effectiveness Survey



The N.C. Center for Public Policy Research conducted its legislative effectiveness survey in October through December 2013. At that time, 50* state Senators, 120** Representatives, 438 registered lobbyists (including the lead state agency legislative liaisons), and 36 state capital news correspondents were asked to rate the effectiveness of each member of the North Carolina General Assembly on a scale of one to 10. Senators were asked to rank only other Senators, and Representatives rated only their fellow Representatives.

Sixty-three of the 120 House members (53%) responded to the Center's survey, as did 33 of the 50 Senators (66%), 159 of the 438 lobbyists and lead legislative liaisons based in North Carolina (36%), and 6 of 36 capital news correspondents (17%). The overall response rate was 40%.

The survey's purpose was to identify the most effective legislators in the General Assembly. The Center asked respondents to base their ratings on legislators' participation in committee work, their skill at guiding bills through committee and floor debate, their general knowledge and expertise in special fields, the respect they command from peers, their ethics, the enthusiasm with which they execute various legislative responsibilities, the political power they hold (by virtue of office, longevity, or personal skills), their ability to sway the opinions of fellow legislators, and their aptitude for the overall legislative process.

The following pages list the effectiveness rankings for the 2013 North Carolina Senate and House of Representatives and include rankings from previous legislative sessions where applicable.

*Note: In 2013, the legislature met in regular session from Jan. 9, 2013 to July 26, 2013, and in a reconvened session on Sept. 3-4, 2013. Only 49 of the state's 50 Senators are included in the rankings. Sen. Martin Nesbitt died on March 6, 2014 and is not included in the rankings.

Sen. Eleanor Kinnaird resigned Aug. 19, 2013, and Rep. Valerie Foushee was appointed on Sept. 13, 2013 to replace her. Sen. Kinnaird is included in the Senate rankings, while Sen. Foushee is not. Foushee is included in the House rankings.

Sen. Pete Brunstetter resigned Dec. 15, 2013, and Joyce Krawiec was appointed on Jan. 10, 2014 to replace him. Sen. Brunstetter is included in the rankings, while Sen. Krawiec is not.

**Note: Representatives were included on this survey if they served for a significant portion of the 2013 sessions.

Rep. Deborah Ross resigned June 1, 2013, and Grier Martin was appointed on June 1, 2013 to replace her. Rep. Deborah Ross is included in the rankings, while Rep. Grier Martin is not.

Rep. Jerry Dockham resigned July 1, 2013, and Roger Younts was appointed on July 15, 2013 to replace him. Rep. Dockham is included in the rankings, while Rep. Younts is not.

Rep. Valerie Foushee resigned from the House on Sept. 25, 2013 to take a seat in the Senate, and Graig Meyer was appointed on Oct. 30, 2013 to replace her. Rep. Foushee is included in the House rankings, while Rep. Meyer is not.

Rep. Deb McManus resigned Dec. 11, 2013, and Robert Reives was appointed on Jan. 29, 2014 to replace her. Rep. McManus is included in the rankings, while Rep. Reives is not.

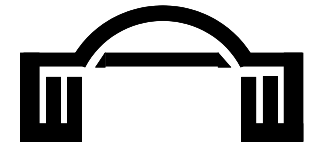

ATTENDANCE RULES FOR EACH CHAMBER

SENATE RULE 70. Absence without leave: No Senator or officer of the Senate shall depart the service of the Senate without leave or receive pay as a Senator or officer for the time absent without leave.

HOUSE RULE 54. Attendance of Members: No member or officer of the House shall be absent from the service of the House without leave, unless from sickness or disability.

TERMS USED IN ATTENDANCE TABLES

Party-County: This is the political party and the home county of the legislator. (“D” indicates Democrat, “R” indicates Republican).

Legislative Days: This is the total number of days the legislative chamber met during 2013. The Senate and House both met for 104 days in their regular long session between Jan. 9, 2013 and July 26, 2013 and for 2 additional days in a reconvened session on Sept. 3-4, 2013 for a total of 106 legislative days.

Days Fully Absent: This is the number of legislative days for which official records of the House and the Senate indicate that a member received an excused absence from the legislative session for the entire day.

Days Partially Absent: This is the number of legislative days that official records of the House and the Senate indicate that a member received an excused absence from the legislative session for a portion of the day.

Total Days with Absences: This is the number of days partially absent added to the number of days fully absent.

Legislative Days Present: This is the number of days that each legislator was present for the entire day. It is calculated by subtracting the total number of days the legislator was recorded as being absent from the total number of legislative days.

Percentage of Days Present: This is the percentage of total legislative days for which the legislator was present. It is obtained by dividing the number of days present by the total number of legislative days.

Attendance Rank: This is a ranking of legislators by the percentage of days present. A lower ranking indicates higher attendance while a higher ranking indicates lower attendance.

VOTING PARTICIPATION RULES FOR EACH CHAMBER

SENATE RULE 29. Duty to vote; excuses. – (a): Every Senator who is within the Senate Chamber when the question is stated by the Presiding Officer shall vote thereon unless that Senator is excused by the Senate.

HOUSE RULE 24. Roll Call Vote. – (b): Every member who is in the Hall of the House when the question is put shall vote upon a call of the ayes and noes, unless excused pursuant to Rule 24.1A. [*Rule 24.1A details excuses.*]

TERMS USED IN VOTING PARTICIPATION TABLES

Party-County: This is the political party and the home county of the legislator. (“D” indicates Democrat, “R” indicates Republican).

Senate’s/House’s Total Votes: This is the total number of electronically recorded roll call votes for that chamber during the 2013 legislative session. The Senate recorded 916 roll call votes, and the House recorded 1,354 votes.

Absent or Excused from Voting: This is the total number of electronically recorded roll call votes for which the legislator was absent or excused from voting under the rules.

Maximum Votes Could Have Cast While Present: This is the number of votes a legislator could have cast once the number of absent or excused votes for each legislator is subtracted from the total votes taken that session.

Actual Votes Cast: This is the actual number of electronically recorded roll call votes cast by the legislator.

Voting Participation Percentage: This is the percentage of actual votes cast out of the maximum votes a legislator could have cast while present. It is calculated by dividing the actual votes cast by the maximum votes the legislator could have cast while present.

Voting Participation Rank: This is a ranking of legislators by their voting participation percentage. A lower ranking indicates a higher voting percentage while a higher ranking indicates a lower voting percentage.
