TEMPORARY RESTRAINING ORDER

THIS MATTER coming on to be heard before the undersigned judge on the Plaintiff's Motion for Temporary Restraining Order, and the Court having reviewed the Verified Complaint, Writ of Mandamus and Motion for Temporary Restraining Order, and the court having reviewed the Affidavit of Attorney Thomas M. Van Camp regarding notice to the adverse party, is of the opinion that the Motion for Temporary Restraining Order should be ALLOWED. In support of this Order, the Court makes the following findings:


1. There is a likelihood that the Plaintiff will succeed on the merits of his claims against the Defendant and will succeed in passing a local bill to allow for the recall of the current Moore County Board of Education.
2. That if, pending the Plaintiff's efforts, as an elected Representative of the people of Moore County, the Moore County Board of Education hires a permanent replacement in the position of Superintendent, the Plaintiff and the citizens and residents of Moore County will suffer immediate and irreparable harm including but not limited to (1) the expending of unnecessary taxpayer money for the employment of a permanent Superintendent while paying out Dr. Grimesey's contract; (2) the exodus of teachers from the Moore County School system; and (3) the loss of morale and confidence in the Moore County Board of Education by teachers, students, and parents.

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED, ADJUDGED, AND DECREED as follows:

1. That the Defendant is restrained and prohibited from hiring a permanent replacement of Dr. Grimesey for the position of Superintendent of Moore County Schools until further Order of this Court;
2. That this Temporary Restraining Order shall become effective immediately and shall remain in full force and effect until the Court hears and determines the Plaintiff's Motion for Preliminary Injunction which is hereby set for hearing on JUNE 15th, 2015 at 2:00 P.M. o'clock in the Moore County Courthouse, Carthage, NC, and, in the Court's discretion, Plaintiff is not required to post bond.
