




In 2015-16, there were approximately 29,000 students enrolled in the NC Pre-K program, with more than 7,000 additional eligible four-year-olds on the waitlist. Since 2009, the percentage of children from low-income backgrounds enrolled in any type of preschool program has increased from 64% to 68%.






K-12 Enrollment Trends




North Carolina is one of just six states nationally that provide at least 10% more per pupil funding to high-poverty districts than low poverty districts




In 2014-15, North Carolina ranked 40th in the country in total K-12 per pupil funding, and 13th for the percentage of education funding provided by the state.




From 2006 to 2016, if K-12 staff had increased at the same rate as student enrollment (+5%), more than 4,000 new teachers would have been added. Instead, just 292 teachers were added, while over 2,500 additional supervisors, managers, and other professionals were hired

State per pupil funding for the UNC System and North Carolina Community College system institutions has declined nearly 20% in the past ten years.



Student Outcomes

The Programme for International Student Assessment (PISA) is a triennial survey of 15year-old students in science, reading, and math. North Carolina participated as a "country" this year, and our performance closely mirrored the United States as a whole. Benchmarked against all 35 OECD countries, North Carolina ranks in the middle of the pack in science and reading, and near the bottom in math.
