You will direct our editorial work and lead our diverse editorial team and writers around the South. You will translate Scalawag's mission into a set of editorial priorities, ensure day-today execution, and pilot Scalawag through critical conversations. You'll recommend, design, and launch new multimedia reporting initiatives—and you'll work in a peer-partner relationship with our Publisher to set Scalawag's strategic direction.

Who we are:

Scalawag is a media startup focused on the American South, pioneering a new model of non-profit, mission-driven journalism. Based in Durham, North Carolina, we're entering our third year as a print quarterly with additional online content. We amplify voices of writers, artists, and thinkers to reckon with the South—and our work has been featured in *The New York Times, The Nation, The New Republic*, and *The Atlantic*. Our young, diverse, Southern team has experience in presidential campaigns, top management consulting firms, civil rights law, academic research, non-profit development, and journalism across the South.

Key responsibilities:

- Represent Scalawag and evangelize for its mission, work, and team;
- Manage Scalawag's day-to-day editorial operations, working with the editorial team to ensure a steady stream of high-quality online content;
- Plan and supervise the editorial production of Scalawag's four print issues each year;
- Solicit and edit articles from leading writers across the South;
- Work with Scalawag's social media manager to promote content online and build Scalawag's audience;
- Continually refine Scalawag's editorial strategy and processes in concert with the editorial team;
- Choose, design, and launch signature multimedia projects of reporting and critical commentary;
- Work with the Publisher and Board of Directors to set Scalawag's overall strategic direction.

- A self-directed leader focused on driving Scalawag and its team to success;
- Experienced as an editor at a major publication;
- A journalist who has demonstrate reporting that centers marginalized and directly-impacted communities;

- An exceptional writer with substantial volume of published reporting and/or critical commentary.
