The HCC presidential finalists are (in alphabetical order):

Patrena Benton Elliott, Ph.D., is Vice President for Instruction and Student Support Services/Chief Academic and Student Affairs Officer at Robeson Community College in Lumberton, NC. She previously served as Dean of Academic Affairs and Operations at South University in High Point, NC. Dr. Elliott earned a Doctor of Philosophy in Leadership Studies and a Master of Science in Adult Education from North Carolina Agricultural and Technical State University in Greensboro, NC; and a Bachelor of Arts in Communication Studies from the University of North Carolina at Chapel Hill in Chapel Hill, NC.

Pamela Monaco, Ph.D., is Vice President of Academic and Student Affairs at Wilbur Wright College in Chicago, IL. She previously served as Dean of Instruction at Wilbur Wright College in Chicago, IL. Dr. Monaco earned a Doctor of Philosophy in English and a Master of Arts in English from Catholic University of America in Washington, D.C; and a Bachelor of Business Administration in Marketing from George Washington University in Washington, D.C.

Carmen Nunalee, Ed.D. J.D., is Vice President of Strategy and Performance and Dean of the Crutchfield Campus at Stanly Community College in Albemarle, NC. She previously served as Vice President of Strategic Planning and Compliance at Stanly Community College in Albemarle, NC.
