Bonus Program Study and Report

House Bill 259, 7A.3.(j)

Date Due: March 15, 2024

Submitted by the State Board of Education

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REPORT

House Bill 259 legislated a major study of all bonus programs in the agency, Advanced Courses, Career and Technical Education, and Growth-Based.

This new report, NCGA Report: Consolidated Teacher Bonus Program Study and Report, requires several components that must go through a statistical analysis based on the January 2023 and January 2024 bonuses awarded.

Since January 2024 bonuses were just recently awarded, a statistical analysis has not yet been completed. This study and report will be presented to the State Board of Education as soon as the analyses are completed.

REPORTING REQUIREMENTS

The report shall include, at a minimum, the following information:

(1) Number of students enrolled and taking examinations in each of the following categories of courses:

- a. Advanced Placement.
- b. International Baccalaureate Diploma Programme.
- c. Cambridge AICE program.
- d. Courses needed for the attainment of an industry certification or credential.

(2) Number of students receiving outcomes on examinations resulting in the award of a bonus for a teacher in each category of courses identified in sub-subdivision a. of subdivision (1) of this subsection.

(3) Number of teachers receiving a bonus in each category of courses identified in sub-subdivision a. of subdivision (1) of this subsection.

(4) The amounts awarded to teachers for each category of courses identified in sub-subdivision a. of subdivision (1) of this subsection.

(5) The type of industry certifications and credentials earned by the students, the value ranking for each certification and credential, the number of bonuses earned for each certification or credential, and the total bonus amount awarded for each certification or credential.

(6) Average bonus amount awarded to each qualifying teacher who is an eligible teacher under sub-sub-subdivision a.1., b.1., or c.1. of subdivision (3) of subsection (b) of this section.

(7) The percentage of teachers who received a bonus pursuant to this section and were eligible to receive a bonus for teaching in the same grade level or course in January 2022 or January 2023, or both, where applicable, pursuant to one of the following programs:

- a. The Advanced Course and CTE Bonus Program provided in Section 7A.4 of S.L. 2021-180.
- b. The Growth-Based Teacher Bonus Program is provided in Section 7A.2 of S.L. of 2022-74.

(8) The percentage of teachers who received a bonus pursuant to this section and received a bonus for teaching in the same grade level or course in either January 2022 or January 2023 pursuant to one of the programs listed in subdivision (7) of this subsection.

(9) The percentage of teachers who received a bonus pursuant to this section and received a bonus for teaching in the same grade level or course in January 2022 or January 2023, or both, where applicable, pursuant to one of the programs listed subdivision (7) of this subsection.

(10) The statistical relationship between a teacher receiving a bonus in January 2024 or 2025 pursuant to this section and receiving a bonus pursuant to a predecessor bonus program. For purposes of this subdivision, the following are predecessor programs:

- a. Bonuses awarded pursuant to Section 7A.4(c) of S.L. 2021-180 are predecessors to bonuses awarded pursuant to subsection (c) of this section.
- b. Bonuses awarded pursuant to Section 7A.4(d) of S.L. 2021-180 are predecessors to bonuses awarded pursuant to subsection (d) of this section.
- c. Bonuses awarded pursuant to subdivision (1) of subsection (c) and subdivision (1) of subsection (d) of Section 7A.2 of S.L. 2022-74 are predecessors to bonuses awarded pursuant to subdivision (1) of subsection (f) and subdivision (1) of subsection (g) of this section.
- d. Bonuses awarded pursuant to subdivision (2) of subsection (c) and subdivision (2) of subsection (d) of Section 7A.2 of S.L. 2022-74 are predecessors to bonuses awarded pursuant to subdivision (2) of subsection (f) and subdivision (2) of subsection (g) of this section.
- e. Bonuses awarded pursuant to subdivision (c)(3) and subdivision (d)(3) of Section 7A.2 of S.L. 2022-74 are predecessors to bonuses awarded pursuant to subdivision (3) of subsection (f) and subdivision (3) of subsection (g) of this section.

(11) The distribution of statewide and local growth bonuses awarded pursuant to this section as among qualifying public school units and, where applicable, schools within those units.

INITIAL DATA REGARDING CTE CREDENTIALS AND BONUSES ARE BELOW:

The Department of Public Instruction collaborated with the Department of Commerce's Labor and Economic Analysis Division (LEAD) to identify the academic rigor and employment value of the industry recognized credentials earned by secondary students in Career and Technical Education (CTE) programs during the 2015-16 school year. Based on the data gathered, in December 2016, the State Board of Education approved a bonus program based on three tiers of credentials. Those credentials with both high academic rigor and employment value were designated as Tier 3 and eligible for a bonus of \$50 each. Tier 2 credentials have either high academic rigor or high employment value and will receive a \$25 bonus. Tier 1 credentials, while still valuable to students, did not have either high academic rigor or high employment value and therefore, are not eligible for teacher bonus pay.

Employment value was calculated based on the entry wages, employment growth rate and the projected number of job openings for the primary occupation of each credential earned. The process was similar to the methodology used by LEAD in the Star Job Ratings reporting. DPI and LEAD used several data sources to match occupations with credentials. However, the alignment process is not a perfect science. Many credentials earned can be aligned with more than one occupation or group of occupations. The CTE Credential Tier Designation is re-evaluated annually. Tables 1, 2, and 3 detail the 2021-2022 assignment of each credential type to a Tier based on the methodology used by DPI and LEAD.

Summary:

Following the COVID-19 pandemic, a rebound in credential attainment is evident by the 2021-2022 steep increase in individual credentials earned to 239,200. Additional funding provided by the North Carolina General Assembly and continued improvement efforts contributed to another steep increase in 2022-2023 to 325,784 individual credentials earned. The funding progression is described below.

- In 2020-2021 and prior years, local districts received approximately 10% of the needed funding to offer all students credentialing opportunities.
- In 2021-2022, funding increased to accommodate approximately 43% of the funding needed to offer all students the opportunity to earn credentials aligned with their CTE courses.
- During the 2022-2023, the funding once again increased, reaching \$15.8 million, and local districts were funded over 98% of the needed amount to offer all students the opportunity to earn credentials aligned with their CTE courses. The impact of this additional funding is reflected in the 2022-2023 credential attainment of 325,784, the highest number earned since data collection started in 2010-2011.
- The overall increase in credentials earned is reflected in the industry-valued Tier 2 and Tier 3 credentials. Tier 2 credentials earned increased by 28% in 2022-2023 and Tier 3 credentials increased by 13%.

- The 2022-2023 average bonus received per teacher was \$860, an increase from \$806 in 2021-2022.

Impact:

To determine the impact that the CTE teacher credential payment has on our teacher retainment, NC DPI CTE issued a survey in May 2023 to CTE teachers who received the credential bonus for the 2021-2022 year. Survey feedback was received from 408 teachers who were issued the credential bonus payment for credentials earned in the 2021-2022 academic year.

- Of the 408 respondents, 35% (141) said the credential bonus payment influenced their decision to remain in the teaching profession. In the prior year, 38% responded favorably to this question.
- Of the 408 respondents 24% (96) said the credential bonus payment influenced their decision to expand or change the courses taught. In the prior year, 20% responded favorably to this question.
- Of the 408 respondents, 22% (89) said they were made aware of the teacher credential bonus payment when they entered the teaching profession. In the prior year, 20% responded favorably to this question.
