

What is NC College Connect?

NC College Connect is a program created with the goal of increasing access to highereducation by directly admitting North Carolina public high schoolseniors to select UNC System universities, North Carolina Independent Colleges and Universities, and their local North Carolina community college where they already meet admissions requirements.

How Will Students Know They're Eligible?

- Students will be directly admitted to select colleges and universities where they meet GPA and NC College Connect requirements.
- Eligible students will receive an official letter in the mailby the start of their senior school year—and can visit their portal on NCC ollege Connect.org to see a full list of colleges and universities where they've been admitted. Each student will see a tailored set of colleges based on their GPA (2.8 Unweighted GPA and course requirements).
- Schools will have a list of eligible students, too.



How Will Students Accept Their Admission?

- 1. Eligible students will receive a letter in the mail. Or students can check their CFNC portals in early August.
- 2. Students should scan the QRcode on their letter to visit NCCollegeConnect.org, where they can access the application portal.
- 3. After logging in, students will see a complete list of institutions where they have been offered admission. They will have the option to complete a NC College Connect form to accept their admission for each college or university of their choice.
- 4. Once students complete the NC CC form, students will continue to be recruited from colleges/universities. When students make their decision, they will enroll!



Currently On- Going 2025-26

→ Phase 2: Direct Admissions

UNC, CC and NCICU institutions are participating.

This week, 62,959 NC public high school Seniors have been directly admitted to at least 34 NC colleges and universities. Some have been admitted to 41 colleges.

Students fill out a simple NC-CC form to accept their admissions—then enroll when they are ready to commit!

Keep in Mind



Remember - during College Application Week (Oct. 20 – 26, 2025) most application fees will be waived. Make sure students submit their applications this October!

While students may qualify for direct admission to the colleges and universities that are a part of NC College Connect, students are encouraged to apply to any other North Carolina college or university they would like via CFNC.org, based on their priorities and *interests*. However, once students have submitted the form through NC College Connect, there is no need to submit another application
