1.5–2.5x



7th and 8th grade math students saw **1.5–2.5x expected growth** on average, each semester on the iReady assessment.

2–3x



5th grade reading students saw **2–3x expected growth** on average this spring on the DIBELS and iReady assessments.

Teach For America is growing the **tutor-to-teacher pipeline** through Ignite

Since the launch of the program, **550 Ignite fellows** have joined the TFA teaching corps

In the 2024–25 school year alone, approximately 280 teachers—**6% of the total TFA corps**—brought their Ignite tutoring experience to leading classrooms
