State Ethics Reminders

Persons subject to the State Government Ethics Act must file a Statement of Economic Interest ("SEI") prior to being appointed, employed, or elected and annually by April 15th of each year.

Must also complete ethics training. Within 6 months of starting and refresher every two years thereafter.

Cape View Leadership Academy

The EICS Committee, through the duly appointed Appeals Hearing Panel, recommends to the State Board of Education that it remand the appeal by Cape View Leadership Academy from the Charter Schools Review Board's December 8, 2025 decision to deny a charter back to the Charter Schools Review Board for consideration at its March 2026 meeting. ***The remand to the Charter Schools Review Board is for the limited purpose of allowing ACCEL, Cape View Leadership Academy's selected EMO, to present information and respond to questions by the Charter Schools Review Board about Cape View Leadership Academy's charter application.***

2026 Transportation Grant

- **74 charter schools** received awards (11 more than 2025)
- **\$8.8 million** in eligible expenses submitted, up from \$8.1 million in 2025
- **\$2.5 million** in state funding distributed in February 2026
- Schools received approximately **31% reimbursement** of eligible expenses (reduced from statutory max of 65% due to high demand)
- **No spring semester application** — funding fully expended after fall awards
