# **Remote Charter Academy (RCA) Statutes + Application Process**

# § 115C-218.120. Remote charter academies

## Full Virtual OR Face Virtual

- (A) As part of an application or modification of a charter, a nonprofit may apply to the Review Board for approval to include a remote charter academy that meets the requirements of this Part as part of the nonprofit's charter.
  - (1) Provide only remote instruction to enrolled students served by the charter...
  - (2) Provide remote instruction to students enrolled in the remote charter academy and provide in-person instruction to other students served by the charter.
  - (3) Provide enrolled students both remote instruction and in-person instruction. A student who receives more than half of the student's instruction through remote instruction shall be classified as enrolled in the charter's remote charter academy.

# § 115C-218.120.

## Remote charter academies

### Statewide OR Regional

- (B) As part of the application or modification of a charter, the nonprofit shall designate which of the following enrollment areas the remote charter academy will use to enroll students:
  - (1) A **statewide** remote charter academy that admits students in accordance with G.S. 115C-218.45.
  - (2) A **regional** remote charter academy that, notwithstanding G.S. 115C-218.45(a), admits students only from the county in which the charter school facility is located and the counties of the State geographically contiguous to that county.

# Amendments: RCA Application Process

- **Application** opened in October 2025
- **Deadline** of January 16, 2026
- **Feedback** provided on application by OCS staff
- **CSRB approval** including interview process + vote
- **Requirements:**
  1. Application
  2. Remote Instruction Plan
  3. Budget
  4. Board meeting minutes that reflect approval
  5. Cover letter signed by school leader and board chair

# RCAs: By the Numbers

**17 total** approved Remote Charter Academies (RCAs)

- **10** operating 25-26 SY
- **5** currently scheduled to open in **SY 2026–27**

**4** stand alone PSUs

**13** approved through the amendment process

- 1 requesting 3rd deferral
- 1 not opening after 2 deferrals

### REMOTE CHARTER APPLICATION AMENDMENT INTERVIEW

This is the guidance and time guidelines for operating schools seeking an amendment to offer a Remote Charter Academy (RCA). Applicants should attend the CSRB interview with the appropriate staff – the school leader and any other critical RCA staff. Board representation is also encouraged.

Each applicant is allotted 30 minutes as follows:

Time	Procedure
5 mins.	Applicant gives a brief opening statement introducing the school and answering questions such as:  Why does the school need an RCA? What is the proposed RCA structure (full-time remote students, mixed remote/in-person, or separate remote and in-person cohorts)? What is the projected enrollment? and any other basics needed to understand the request.
15 mins.	Full CSRB discussion of application/presentation of questions to school leader/staff/board members.
5 mins.	Applicant Closing Statement – this is an opportunity for the applicant board to close its interview and wrap up any final statements to the CSRB.
5 mins.	Full CSRB deliberation and vote.  At this time, applicants <u>SHOULD NOT</u> speak unless directly asked a question.
