# New Remote Academy Proposals

- Brunswick (K–12, blended, 150 students)
- Northampton (6–12, virtual, 25 students)
- Wayne (6–12, blended, 200 students)
- Asheboro (6–12, blended, 150 students)
- Hyde (K–12, blended, 2 schools, 460 combined)

# Key Purpose Themes:

- Expand school choice
- Retain and re-engage students
- Address barriers (health, geography, life circumstances)
- Provide flexible, high-quality pathways

# Instructional Model (Across PSUs)

## Blended or fully virtual learning models

### Combination of:

- Live instruction (synchronous)
- Self-paced learning (asynchronous)

## Use of LMS platforms and digital curriculum tools

- School-issued devices for all students
- Required state assessments and accountability measures

# Revisions & Closures

## Revisions driven by enrollment trends:

- Wilson: shifting grades to 8–12 (removing 6-7)
- Caldwell: shifting grades to 6–12 (removing 4-5)

## Closures:

- Burke Virtual Academy (no enrollment)
- Pitt County Virtual School (declining enrollment)
